

BLUEBIRD SPECIAL

Because bluebirds like to nest in houses erected for them around our homes, this plan is suggested as one of the simplest and most efficient boxes to build. The key to success is to have the entrance hole 1 1/2 inches in diameter and no perch just beneath the entrance. These two features discourage other birds which may attempt to use the house. For best results the house should be from 8 to 10 feet above the ground, and have a hinged top or bottom so the box may be cleaned out after each nesting.

Use 3/4" thick board
